HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

As an alternative to voting at the election commission office on Election Day, the voter may vote by absentee ballot or in person during the early voting period. Forms are available online or in our office, or the voter may send a written request with ALL of the required information listed below. * *(Note – If the voter registered by mail, then he/she must vote in person for the first election in which he/she votes after registering, UNLESS he/she qualifies for the permanent absentee register and has filed the appropriate physician's statement.)*

*To vote an absentee ballot by-mail, the voter must make the request in writing and include ALL of the following information:

1. his/her name (as registered); and
2. date of birth; and
3. Social Security number;
4. residence address (911 address); and
5. mailing address (if different from residence address and the reason requires it); and
6. the election(s) in which he/she wishes to vote; and
7. the reason he/she is requesting to vote an absentee ballot**; and
8. his/her signature.

*****Legal Reasons for Voting Absentee Are (Please Choose ONE):**

- I am a caretaker of a hospitalized, ill or disabled person.
- I am a voter with a disability whose polling place is inaccessible.
- I will be serving on jury duty in state or federal court.
- I am sixty (60) years of age or older.
- I am on the permanent absentee voting register.
- I will be serving as an election official or a member or employee of the election commission on election day.
- I cannot appear during the early voting period or at my polling place because I will be observing a religious holiday.
- I will be outside the county in which I am registered during the early voting period and on election day during all hours the polls are open.

- I am enrolled as a full-time student (or I am the spouse of a student) at _____ (list school), which is *inside* Tennessee and *outside* the county where I am registered.
- I am a candidate for office in the election for which I am applying to vote absentee by mail.
- I am hospitalized, ill, or physically disabled and because of such condition, I am unable to appear at my polling place for this election.
- I am a member of the military, or I am a family member to a member of the military, or I am an overseas citizen and otherwise qualified to vote in Tennessee. **Ballot to be sent: By Mail / Electronically (list e-mail address):** _____
- I have a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) (or I am the spouse of a person possessing a CDL), or I have a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) and will be out of the county during the open hours of early voting and election day, and I have no specific out-of-county or out-of-state address to receive mail during this time. Enclosed is a copy of my CDL or my spouse's CDL or a copy of my TWIC card. **My CDL/TWIC Number (list number):** _____
