HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

As an alternative to voting at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, the voter may vote by absentee ballot or during the early voting period. Forms are available on our website (above) or in our office, or the voter may send a written request with ALL of the required information listed below. ** (Note – If the voter registered by mail, then he/she must vote in person for the first election in which he/she votes after registering, UNLESS he/she qualifies for the permanent absentee register and has filed the appropriate physician's statement.) **To request an absentee ballot based on age alone, you are required to be at least 60 years of age.**

**To vote an absentee ballot by-mail, the voter must make the request in writing and include ALL of the following information:

1. his/her name (as registered); and
2. date of birth; and
3. social security number; and
4. residence address (911 address); and
5. mailing address (if different from residence address); and

6. the election(s) in which he/she wishes to vote; and
7. the reason he/she is requesting to vote an absentee ballot; and
8. his/her signature.

The written request must be received by mail or fax or e-mail no later than October 30, 2012.

PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION

Federal or state government-issued photo ID is now required to vote in the state of Tennessee, unless an exception applies. College student IDs will not be accepted for this purpose. ALL RUTHERFORD COUNTY REGISTERED VOTERS ARE NOW LOCATED IN THE 4TH U.S. CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT.
