Computer Registrar: This person greets the voters and checks to make sure they are registered, prints a ballot application and has voter sign a signature list, then sends them to the voting machine.

Computer Tech: This person will set up, maintain then break down laptop computers and printers at the polling place. (Computer experience preferred)

Voting Machine Operator: This person will assist the voter at the voting machine.

Officer of Elections: This person is responsible for overseeing all procedures and workers at the precinct polling place on Election Day.
